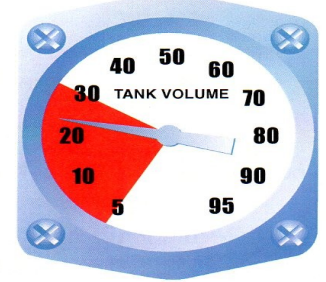

Cooking With Gas

Vegan Pumpkin Soup

1 medium (about 5 lbs) pumpkin, cut it in half.
Scoop out the seeds and reserve for toasting with cinnamon, nutmeg, and salt, and use as a garnish.
Place the pumpkin in a roasting pan cut side down and poke holes in the skin side with a fork.
Then, fill the pan with about a half inch of water and bake at 350 until tender.
Thinly slice a large onion and cook it very slowly for 1-hour in some olive oil to caramelize it.
When the pumpkin is soft, scoop out the insides and add to the onions along with 2 cups of veggie stock and 1 can of coconut milk. Then add 1 tablespoon curry, 1 teaspoon ground ginger, salt and pepper to taste, a dash of cinnamon puree. Add any more stock or seasonings to taste.

- **Standard furnace air filters should be replaced every 30-60 days. A filter is inexpensive compared to the increased fuel cost of operating the furnace with a dirty filter.**
- **To avoid scalding and to save energy, set your water heater to NOT HIGHER than 120 degrees.**
