- ✓ Change your furnace filter monthly to increase efficiency.
- ✓ Invest in a programmable thermostat timer that allows you to lower your home's temperature when you're not there. You can cut annual heating bills by as much as 10 percent per year by turning your thermostat back 10-15 percent for eight hours per day.
- ✓ Protect against drafts by caulking and weather stripping around windows, doors and other openings.
- ✓ Close vents and doors in unused rooms. Make sure your attic and basement are insulated properly.
- ✓ Decrease your water heating bill by turning down your water heater from the standard 120 degrees to 115 degrees.
- ✓ Install flow-restricting shower heads and reduce your hot water usage by up to 50 percent without reducing pressure.

Cooking With Gas

Lorna's Layered Bean Dip

- 2 Cups refried black or pinto beans, homemade or canned
- 1 Tbs. Chili powder, chipotle powder or adobo sauce
- 1 tsp. Ground Cumin
- 1 tsp. Salt
- Freshly ground pepper
- 1 Cup grated Cheddar cheese
- ½ Cup chopped Anaheim chilies or ¼ chopped jalapeños
- 1 Large chopped tomato
- 1 Avocado peeled and chopped
- ½ Cup Greek yogurt, sour cream, or crème fraiche
- 2 thinly sliced green onions, chopped cilantro

Heat the beans in a skillet with a little bit of olive oil.

Add spices, salt and pepper.

Add a little water if to get a smooth consistency.

Spread the beans evenly in a warmed * serving dish.

Add the cheese so it will melt in the top of the beans.

Layer on the chilies, avocado, tomato, sour cream or

yogurt. Top with the onions and cilantro.

Serve immediately with tortilla chips

* Warm serving dish in 150 deg oven
